The Singyang Village Homestay is located in the village of Singyang. The village is made up of a cluster of cardamom landholdings mainly of the Bhutia community. Singyang is located just below Pelling and the homestay is 3 km from Pelling and boasts of excellent views of the mountain (Mt. Khanchendzonga and its neighbouring peaks). The homestay can also cater to large groups of 20 to 30 people. The homestays are managed by evenly distributing the guests to individual homestay for food and accommodation in the village, accompanied by guided activities and tours of the area. Guests can participate and enjoy the unique way of life of the Bhutia community and its traditions in the village. With its lush biodiversity, vegetation, its mountain people, the mighty peaks gracing it, Singyang has it all and is yet undiscovered as a true destination for ecotourism.


